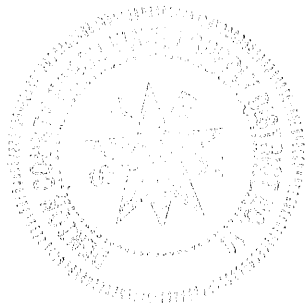



**NOTICE OF MEETING

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 10 will hold a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, July 24, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. at the Savannah Clubhouse, 701 Savannah Boulevard, Savannah, Texas, inside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Determine quorum; Call to order;
2. Consider public comments;
3. Consider review and acceptance of Engineer's report, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith, including:
 - a) Consider approval of award of construction contract(s) for improvement projects, including Artesia Phase 1 Road Repairs;
4. Consider status of District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2013, and the taking of any actions necessary or appropriate in connection therewith, including amendment of Order Authorizing the Issuance of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 10 Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2013; Levying an Ad Valorem Tax in Support of the Bonds; Approving an Official Statement; Authorizing the Execution of a Bond Purchase Agreement, a Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement and an Escrow Agreement; Establishing the Procedures of Selling and Delivering the Bonds; and Authorizing Other Matters Related to the Issuance of the Bonds;
5. Consider status of District's Unlimited Tax Road Refunding Bonds, Series 2013, and the taking of any actions necessary or appropriate in connection therewith, including amendment of Order Authorizing the Issuance of Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 10 Unlimited Tax Road Refunding Bonds, Series 2013; Levying an Ad Valorem Tax in Support of the Bonds; Approving an Official Statement; Authorizing the Execution of a Bond Purchase Agreement, a Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement and an Escrow Agreement; Establishing the Procedures of Selling and Delivering the Bonds; and Authorizing Other Matters Related to the Issuance of the Bonds;
6. Consider approval of Preliminary Official Statement and Notice of Sale for proposed \$4,380,000 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2013;
7. Consider Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071 (1)(A) and (B), 551.072, and 551.076, Texas Government Code, as amended, to consult with District Counsel, consider real estate matters, and deliberate regarding deployment of security personnel; and
8. Adjourn.
